It is so important that we never forget what happened that day in 2001. It is so important that we stay in prayer for our country. We hope you will humble yourself and pray along with other members of our community as we Cry Out for America's healing on that day and throughout the year.

Were you? Did you? Why didn't you?

O'Malley Family Bible Study Sept 18, 2012 Were you there? Did you repent? Why didn't you hear about it?

Were you there for the Cry out America Repentance assembly on 9/11/12 at the courthouses across the land? Did you repent of your sins? Did you humble and cry out before God to turn back the Holy wrath that is coming down on this country? Why didn't you know that there was a humbling, a day of repentance event going on this day across this nation? All these things I'll discuss in this bible study.

Were you there? No, not from what I saw in Blanco that day. I counted no more than 75 people in attendance. That's included the organizers the 9/11 first responders (firefighters, police and EMS). People were out and about doing their everyday activities. I spoke to the organizing church pastor and he mentioned another religious event was happening that day. The people in Blanco were praying in massive numbers to the god of soccer at the church of the sports field performing and teaching their children all the Rites of the game of play shouting and praising with their lifted hands some even some speaking in tongues. The cars at the sporting event filled the parking spaces and overflowed onto the grass.

If they would have known about the solemn assembly - would they have forsaken their blessed event and taken time to humble themselves to Jesus Christ at a solemn assembly following Jesus' repentance command?

The event time wasn't grievous long. It started at 7pm and ended by 7:30-ish. All the pastors present were welcomed up and each gave a heartfelt prayer for personal & national repentance. That didn't last long since only 6 pastors/deacons were there. Next came the honoring the Firefighters, Police and EMS followed by a final prayer and a dismissal. It was a basic beginner level repentance event that showed honor to our Savior Jesus. Apparently, a half an hour is way too much for most "Christians".

Who was there? The real question was who wasn't there. There are 14 various churches in Blanco but only 5 were represented at the assembly (shown in green below). That is a dismal 28% attendance rate. Ark Revival Ministries organized it and from what I heard and understood sent out invitations to the other churches in the area to attend and tell their congregation to attend.

Mt Horeb Baptist Church's pastor didn't make it but at least they sent a deacon to give a prayer. Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church went overboard and sent 2 pastors – a husband and wife pastor (apparently that church doesn't follow Paul's guidelines on women in the churches – 1Cor14:34-35 women are not to be preachers/teachers/pastors in the pulpits of churches).

1Co 14:34 the women should keep silent in the churches. For they are not permitted to speak, but should be in submission, as the Law also says.

1Co 14:35 If there is anything they desire to learn, let them ask their husbands at home. For it is shameful for a woman to speak in church.

The denominations that were missing were the 2 Churches of Christ, Cowboy Church, the other Baptist and Lutheran Church, the Methodist, the Catholic, Episcopal and the Jehovah's Witness (I don't consider them a church since they define Jesus as Michael the arch angel).



Why couldn't the 14 Churches in Blanco Texas put away their differences and come together to repent and cry out to Jesus for healing of our country? I would not consider my beliefs to be aligned with the various denominational doctrines of the attending churches. I did lay aside those differences and came together with other Jesus believing/confessing/repenting persons. Why didn't the other churches/Christians do the same?

28% church representation is low but looking at the 75 person turn out crowd and last year's population numbers of 1755 gives a whopping 4.2% of the population of the town of Blanco in attendance. On the bright side the organizing Pastor mentioned that there were more in attendance this year compared with last years

Where were the Pastors/Preachers/Church members who call themselves "Christians" but feel no need or desire to attend? What is more important than Jesus? Apparently the pleasures of the flesh were more compelling for them. But the remnant found out, those placing Jesus first in their lives found out and made time in there busy day to rearrange their schedules for that evening.

The bible in Joel1:14 that we are to call for **ALL** the inhabitants of the land to come together for a solemn assembly and cry out to the LORD. Have we as a nation drifted so far away from Jesus that we no longer feel a need to come together with all those confessing that Jesus is Lord and the King of Kings that we stick with our members within our 4 walls and reject the word of God in gathering together?

Joel 1:14 Consecrate a fast; call a solemn assembly. Gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land to the house of the LORD your God, and cry out to the LORD.

America has never been a single religion. Looking at the early colonies of this country (figure 1 below) one sees that these colonies were not comprised of a single denomination but a various band of denominations all confessing that Jesus Christ is Lord. All the denominations did put away their

differences to fight off and with Jesus' help - defeat the greatest army in the world at that time: the British Empire.

**Did you repent**? Is America repenting of her sins? No. Our sins are coming home to roost and we haven't repented as a nation and Jesus will not heal our land without a humbling and crying out as stated in 2 Chronicles 7:14

2Ch 7:14 if my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.



How can churches across the land do 2Chr7:14 if the pastors/preachers/teachers aren't proclaiming it? It's the preacher's basic duty to shepherd their flock to Jesus but all I sensed was that those churches not in attendance: those shepherds had ugly, smelly feet – Rm10:13-15. Those pastors with a legitimate excuse have no excuses for not sending at least one of their members with a written prayer. Mt Horeb Baptist Church did and I do respect them for caring enough to send a representative to the assembly.


Rom 10:13 For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Rom 10:14 How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? Rom 10:15 And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"

Jesus doesn't want to destroy His people and His nations – but He will and He is going to. The nation of Judah was on a precipice, a razor's edge. One step to the right: salvation. One step to the left: destruction by the destroyers. God gave Jerusalem 5 chances to repent. Each plea action got simpler and simpler.

**Plea #1:** In Jeremiah7:5-7 God tells Jerusalem thru the prophet Jeremiah to repent, act lawfully and He won't destroy their country

Jer 7:5 "For if you truly amend your ways and your deeds, if you truly execute justice one with another,





Jer 7:7 then I will let you dwell in this place, in the land that I gave of old to your fathers forever.

That fell on deaf ears since the people couldn't even act righteously. The mercy of the Lord was so great that He didn't want to see the wicked die (Ez33:11) but wanted them to repent.

Eze 33:11 Say to them, As I live, declares the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die, O house of Israel?

**Plea #2:** The Lord gives Jerusalem a second chance of keeping the land and not have their country destroyed. The first plea was obviously too much to do be just, don't oppress, don't kill and don't go after other gods. God drops all the actions except the last one: the Israelites needed to repent and turn back to the LORD.



Jer 15:19 Therefore thus says the LORD: "If you return, I will restore you, and you shall stand before me. If you utter what is precious, and not what is worthless, you shall be as my mouth. They shall turn to you, but you shall not turn to them.

Jer 15:20 And I will make you to this people a fortified wall of bronze; they will fight against you, but they shall not prevail over you, for I am with you to save you and deliver you, declares the LORD.

Jer 15:21 I will deliver you out of the hand of the wicked, and redeem you from the grasp of the ruthless."

This also was too much of a burden. Onwards to Plea#3

**Plea #3:** It's a simple command found in Jeremiah 17:24 – don't work on the Sabbath. If you do that then the Lord said He'd allow the House of Judah to remain on the land and their country would be preserved.



Jer 17:24 "But if you listen to me, declares the LORD, and bring in no burden by the gates of this city on the Sabbath day, but keep the Sabbath day holy and do no work on it,

Jer 17:25 then there shall enter by the gates of this city kings and princes who sit on the throne of David, riding in chariots and on horses, they and their officials, the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And this city shall be inhabited forever.

Jer 17:26 And people shall come from the cities of Judah and the places around Jerusalem, from the land of Benjamin, from the Shephelah, from the hill country, and from the Negeb, bringing burnt offerings and sacrifices, grain offerings and frankincense, and bringing thank offerings to the house of the LORD.

Jer 17:27 But if you do not listen to me, to keep the Sabbath day holy, and not to bear a burden and enter by the gates of Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, then I will kindle a fire in its gates, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem and shall not be quenched."

They couldn't even do that simple command and as a result God was ready to turn them over to the Babylonians however Jesus was willing to give them 2 additional breaks.

- **Plea #4:** Jeremiah finally got thru to the King and the people. Babylon was on the door step but Jerusalem made a deal with God and by their works on carrying out the covenant God turned away Babylon. This is in Jer34:8-10
- Jer 34:8 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after King Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the people in Jerusalem to make a proclamation of liberty to them,
- Jer 34:9 that everyone should set free his Hebrew slaves, male and female, so that no one should enslave a Jew, his brother.
- Jer 34:10 And they obeyed, all the officials and all the people who had entered into the covenant that everyone would set free his slave, male or female, so that they would not be enslaved again. They obeyed and set them free.

Unfortunately like modern day Christians once the danger is gone then their sinful ways return. Once Babylon turned away the Israelites re-enslaved their former slaves.

Jer 34:11 But afterward they turned around and took back the male and female slaves they had set free, and brought them into subjection as slaves.

If you want to torq off God then make a vow with him and break it.

- Jer 34:15 You recently repented and did what was right in my eyes by proclaiming liberty, each to his neighbor, and you made a covenant before me in the house that is called by my name,
- Jer 34:16 but then you turned around and profaned my name when each of you took back his male and female slaves, whom you had set free according to their desire, and you brought them into subjection to be your slaves.
- Jer 34:17 "Therefore, thus says the LORD: You have not obeyed me by proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother and to his neighbor; behold, I proclaim to you liberty to the sword, to pestilence, and to famine, declares the LORD. I will make you a horror to all the kingdoms of the earth.

God then promises to bring back Babylon and destroy the city.

Jer 34:22 Behold, I will command, declares the LORD, and will bring them back to this city. And they will fight against it and take it and burn it with fire. I will make the cities of Judah a desolation without inhabitant."

All seems hopeless but there is the final plea to come and a final chance of Babylon not coming in and burning down the city.

**Plea #5:** I call it the "*Jesus option*". This option is described in Jn11:47-50. Sacrifice 1 man in order for the nation to survive. The Jewish high rollers wanted Jesus to die so the Romans wouldn't come in and destroy the city.

- Joh 11:47 So the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered the Council and said, "What are we to do? For this man performs many signs.
- Joh 11:48 If we let him go on like this, everyone will believe in him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place and our nation."
- Joh 11:49 But one of them, Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all.
- Joh 11:50 Nor do you understand that it is better for you that one man should die for the people, not that the whole nation should perish."

Back at the Babylonian siege of Jerusalem, Jeremiah tells King Zedekiah the Jesus option in Jer38:17-21. If you sacrifice yourself and go turn yourself into Babylonian captivity then your nation will not be destroyed by Babylon and Jerusalem won't be burned and torn down.

Jer 38:17 Then Jeremiah said to Zedekiah, "Thus says the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel: If you will surrender to the officials of the king of Babylon, then your life shall be spared, and this city shall not be burned with fire, and you and your house shall live.

Jer 38:18 But if you do not surrender to the officials of the king of Babylon, then this city shall be given into the hand of the Chaldeans, and they shall burn it with fire, and you shall not escape from their hand."

Jer 38:19 King Zedekiah said to Jeremiah, "I am afraid of the Judeans who have deserted to the Chaldeans, lest I be handed over to them and they deal cruelly with me."

Jer 38:20 Jeremiah said, "You shall not be given to them. Obey now the voice of the LORD in what I say to you, and it shall be well with you, and your life shall be spared.

Jer 38:21 But if you refuse to surrender, this is the vision which the LORD has shown to me:

King Zedekiah was afraid and didn't follow the advice of Jeremiah and used his own playbook and lost the game and as a result his country, his city and the temple of God was destroyed.



All the evils that are coming around us from every angle the Churches and their congregation don't feel a burning need and desire to cry out to Him. Jesus has many ways of clearing all those more important tasks off your plate and will do. In George Washington's vision, He saw an invading army from Europe, Africa and Asia descend on this country and every town and city in this country battles raged on. Then we as a country will cry out when we are about to be utterly destroyed. Pastors/Preachers/Teachers will arise and do their job of leading their flocks.

### Why didn't you hear about it?

- Pastors, preachers, teachers didn't announce it why?

  - They didn't think it was important.
  - Denominational bias they don't want to support any other churches besides themselves, they are blind guides and they are self-righteous in my opinion.

- o They are devil's representative 2Cor11:13-15
- Black out of the media. I listened to all the big named "Christian" music stations on the Austin radio and all mentioned 9/11 events honoring the firemen, police and EMS but none made any reference to this event. I wasn't surprised at their silence.

Act 20:29 I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock;

2Co 11:13 For such men are false apostles, deceitful workmen, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ.

2Co 11:14 And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.

2Co 11:15 So it is no surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. Their end will correspond to their deeds.



I only found out about the event by a leading of the Holy Spirit. I went into the Blanco Post office to halt the mail service for a few days and a flyer (shown on first page) was taped to the glass. I went back a couple of days later and it had been taken down. What intrigued me about the sign was that it mentioned Jesus was the only way. It called for repentance. It mentioned Joel1:14 and 2Chron7:14. You don't see that posted on any Judeo-Christian churches and absolutely not on any "separation of church and state" government buildings.

I found out from the organizer that the fliers were taken down because someone complained. Who would be offended by calling a city to repentance? Someone who hates Jesus Christ, a wicked person destined for a burning on judgment day. Those are the people of Hosea4:8 and Proverbs4:16 &29:27. They are a people without peace Is48:22 they can't get along with their neighbors.

Hos 4:8 They feed on the sin of my people; they are greedy for their iniquity.

Pro 4:16 For they cannot sleep unless they have done wrong; they are robbed of sleep unless they have made someone stumble.

Pro 29:27 An unjust man is an abomination to the righteous, but one whose way is straight is an abomination to the wicked.

Isa 48:22 "There is no peace," says the LORD, "for the wicked."

Jesus' plan must be working as more churches are holding solemn assemblies. When Jesus' plans are in full operation then all the churches will be holding solemn assemblies or they will be rooted up and destroyed.
